## WHY MEMORIZE THE BIBLE?

As a kid growing up, you probably always looked forward to your birthday and Christmas because you were eager to receive gifts that you wanted. As parents, there is a complete reversal in why we anticipate these times of gift-giving. Instead of being so excited to receive gifts, we eagerly anticipate the opportunity to give gifts. There is almost no greater joy as a parent than to see your child's face light up in celebration when they unwrap that coveted gift they've been wanting for so long. It's a God-given desire in us to take joy in giving good gifts to our children (Luke 11:13).

As Christian parents, one of the best gifts that you can give your child as they grow up in your home is a mind that is filled with Scripture. God's Word is more precious than any gold (Ps. 19:10) and helping your child hide it in their heart is one of the ways to avoid sinning (Ps. 119:11) because it arms them with the sword of the Spirit (Eph. 6:17). It is this gospel word that we are praying would not just be heard by our child, but also be accepted and then bear fruit in their life (Mark 4:20). It is our hope and prayer that by using this workbook with your child, God may graciously give your child the best gift of all, the gift of salvation (Eph 2:8-9). May you find great joy in your parenting endeavors as you help your child memorize Scripture.

# HOW TO USE THIS BOOK

This workbook is designed so that the whole family can use it together.

- If you have more than one child in our elementary ministry, **all ages will be working on the same verses and hymns at the same time.** The same passages will be revisited each year, with more verses added as they progress through elementary school. This arrangement provides the opportunity to reinforce what was previously memorized and to incrementally build towards learning longer passages of Scripture.
- Each month will focus on one or two passages. **The highlighted verses tell you which verses to memorize.** In addition to the larger passages, some months will feature a bonus “fighter verse.” These are short verses dedicated to helping your child fight the good fight of faith (1 Tim 6.12).
- All the passages in this workbook were carefully selected as core truths for the children to memorize. Additionally, the Ten Commandments, the books of the Bible, and Hymns of the Month have been included.
- **Students will track their progress during Sunday School using a sticker system.** Each month will have a blank spot for a sticker. Once your child is ready, they can recite the verses to a table leader in their Sunday school class. If they get it correct, they will receive a sticker. The goal is to fill every blank by the end of the school year.
- **Hymns of the month will be tracked during Kids Worship on Sunday evenings.** They will sing the first verse and chorus of each song to receive a sticker.

<sup>4</sup>But God, being rich in mercy, because of the great love with which he loved us, <sup>5</sup>even when we were dead in our trespasses, made us alive together with Christ—by grace you have been saved—<sup>6</sup>and raised us up with him and seated us with him in the heavenly places in Christ Jesus,  
<sup>7</sup>so that in the coming ages he might show the immeasurable riches of his grace in kindness toward us in Christ Jesus.

<sup>18</sup>But if you are led by the Spirit, you are not under the law. <sup>19</sup>Now the works of the flesh are evident: sexual immorality, impurity, sensuality, <sup>20</sup>idolatry, sorcery, enmity, strife, jealousy, fits of anger, rivalries, dissensions, divisions, <sup>21</sup>envy, drunkenness, carousing<sup>1</sup>, and things like these. I warn you, as I warned you before, that those who do such things will not inherit the kingdom of God.

<sup>22</sup>But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness,

<sup>26</sup>Let us not become conceited, provoking one another, envying one another.

## **1 Corinthians 15:1–6**

<sup>1</sup>Now I would remind you, brothers, of the gospel I preached to you, which you received, in which you stand, <sup>2</sup>and by which you are being saved, if you hold fast to the word I preached to you—unless you believed in vain.

<sup>3</sup>For I delivered to you as of first importance what I also received: that Christ died for our sins in accordance with the Scriptures,

<sup>4</sup>that he was buried, that he was raised on the third day in accordance with the Scriptures,

<sup>5</sup>and that he appeared to Cephas, then to the twelve.

<sup>6</sup>Then he appeared to more than five hundred brothers at one time, most of whom are still alive, though some have fallen asleep.

## **Matthew 28:18–20**
