INTRODUCTION

God has determined that his people should be singing people! He gave us a voice that both speaks and sings (unlike any other created being) and reasons to sing (so many!). The Bible tells us that he is a singing God (Zeph. 3:17—the word here for "gladness" indicates singing). Whether we like it or not, we were created to sing. And we were redeemed to sing forever. So, we should learn to love singing in this life!

Part of our responsibilities as parents in discipling our sons and daughters is to teach them how to worship. The most significant act we contribute to corporate worship is singing. You can teach your children this important truth in several ways: 1) model it—demonstrate to them what joyful singing looks/sounds like; 2) teach it—show them where the Bible tells us to sing (Col. 3:16, Ephes. 5:19, Psalm 96, etc.); 3) expect it at church—help know this is what you expect and make sure they are supported in their effort to learn to sing (such as in our excellent Kids Worship program); and 4) practice it at home.

That is what this Family Worship Book was created to do. These are the most popular songs we sing at First Baptist. By using this book at home, you are not just creating opportunities for priceless family worship with songs that have been carefully selected, tested, and approved, but you are preparing your family to contribute to gathered worship with your church.
